TRIBASE COMPLETES MEXICAN PROTOTYPE

Montreal, August 14, 2007 - TriBase Industries Inc. has completed the construction of a prototype house which is destined for the Mexican affordable housing market. This is a key milestone in preparation for a significant pilot project slated for this fall in the state of Michoacán, Mexico.

On the surface, this one bedroom, 43 square meter (427 square feet) house is typical of homes that can be found across Mexico. However, state of the art materials and strict quality control help TriBase deliver a solution that is more energy efficient and more durable than traditional Mexican homes.

Most importantly, the construction of the prototype has validated TriBase's research and development assumptions that it can build homes several times faster than traditional builders: **TriBase's streamlined manufacturing process can build a home in less than four hours and assemble it on site in less than one day.**

This manufacturing and assembly innovation will enable TriBase to build and deliver as many as 100 homes per month to Mexican market.

TriBase's Michoacán Pilot Project commences in September 2007, with the construction of two demonstration houses on a site that can accommodate as many as 800 new homes.

TriBase is a privately held Canadian company, and is focussed on the mass-production of affordable homes dedicated to workforce housing.
